- Instruction of the division of the verbs in Spanish/verbs "ar", "er" and "ir"
- Conjugations and use of the regular "ar" verbs
- Vocabulary of food
- Use of the Spanish-English dictionary
- Reading short stories and answer questions (reading/comprehension)
- Introduction of words used in the construction of questions (cuando, como, donde, etc)

Fourth Grade
